**RULES/REGULATIONS GOVERNING
THE 2010 PRIMARY SCHOOLS NETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

1. *The Championship will be governed according to the International Netball rules and regulations unless provided for in the rules below.*

2. REGISTRATION

- (a) *Registration of teams must be done on the prescribed registration form.*
- (b) *The correct date of birth must be clearly written next to the full name of each player appearing on the registration form.*
- (c) *A player shall be registered for one institution and in one age category.*
- (d) *Registered players must be bona fide members of the institution for which they are registered.*
- (e) *Schools may register only one team.*
- (f) *Completed registration forms must be submitted to the Sports Division by Friday, 18 May 2010.*

3. QUALIFICATION

- (a) *Only bona fide registered players will be allowed to play in the league.*

4. DURATION OF MATCHES

- (a) *Matches will be 40 minutes duration (4/10 minutes quarters).*
- (b) *The interval between each quarter will be determined in accordance with the International Netball Rules.*

5. PLAYING TIMES

- (a) *Matches will begin at 3:00 p.m.*
- (b) *Whenever there are two matches at the same venue, the second match will begin at 4:00 p.m.*

6. REPORTING FOR MATCHES

- (a) *Teams are expected to arrive for a match at least half an hour before the scheduled start (i.e. for matches beginning at 3:00 p.m. teams should arrive by 2:30 pm and for matches beginning at 4:00 p.m. teams should arrive by 3:30 pm)*
- (b) *A school team should be afforded due supervision and MUST be accompanied by a school teacher at ALL its matches.*
- (c) *A team will be considered as having reported for a match, once no less than five players are on hand in the appropriate uniform and accompanied by a teacher.*
- (d) *A team unable to fulfill a match engagement must notify the Sports Division at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the match in question.*

7. LATE ARRIVAL AND “NO SHOW”

- (a) *In the event that a match does not take place because of “no show” or lateness by one or both teams, the matter will be investigated by the Sports Division and a decision will be taken to either award negative 2 points to defaulter(s) or have the match replayed.*
- (b) *Under these circumstances, the match will only be replayed upon receipt by the Sports Division within 72 hours, a report by the defaulter(s), on the circumstances surrounding the lateness or “no show”, provided that the Sports Division is satisfied that the school(s) concerned did all in its (their) power to turn up for the match and to*

be on time, and provided also, that the school(s) concerned did all it (they) could to inform the opposing team(s) about the problem.

- (c) ***Schools found to be in violation of the Late Arrival/No Show regulation, will in addition to the negative 2 points penalty, bear the costs (umpires fees, ground preparation, transportation) associated with the unplayed game.***

8. VENUES

Venues for matches will be Portsmouth, Marigot, Castle Bruce, Roseau, Wesley and Grand Bay.

9. DRESS

- (a) *All players must turn up for their matches in the appropriate school team uniform.*
 (b) *Tights, if worn, must not be longer than the players' skirts or shorts.*
 (c) *All teams are required to wear playing bibs at all their matches.*
 (d) *Players who do not conform to the dress code will be asked to leave the court.*

10. PROCEDURES FOR PROTEST

- (a) *Dissatisfaction with the course of control of a match entitles a team to submit protest in writing to the Sports Division within forty-eight (48) hours of the conclusion of the said match.*
 (b) *Players and team officials may not call off a match which is in progress – only the umpires may do so.*

11. FORFEITS

A team will forfeit match points for the following reasons:

- (a) *Failure to field a minimum of five players (except if excused)*
 (b) *Failure to play or to continue playing.*
 (c) *Failure to turn up for a match without giving due notice (see 6(d)).*
 (d) *Scores for forfeit matches are: 5 goals - 0*

12. POINTS SYSTEM

- (a) *A win (including by forfeit): 2 points*
 (b) *A loss (including by forfeit): 0 points*
 (c) *Loss by forfeit: negative 2 Points*

13. DETERMINING THE WINNERS OF EACH LEAGUE/FESTIVAL

- (a) *In the event that less than six (6) teams register, the competition will be played on a round robin basis.*
 (b) *If teams are grouped in zones, matches will be played on a round-robin basis in each zone, and one or more teams topping the points table in their respective zone will enter the next stage of the league/festival in the quarter finals, semi finals or final of the league/festival.*
 (c) *In determining winners of round –robin leagues/festivals and zones, the following will apply:*
 (i) *Team with most points wins.*
 (ii) *In the event of a tie in points the winner shall be the team which obtained more points when the teams concerned played each other.*
 (iii) *If after (ii) that is a tie in points then the team with the better goal difference wins.*
 (iv) *If after (iii) the tie still exists, then the team with the better goal average wins.*
 (v) *If after (iv) teams are still tied, the teams concerned will play each other.*
 (d) *For all Semi Finals and Finals, Home Court Advantage will go to the team with the better results at the end of the Round Robin.*

14. SUDDEN DEATH

In the event that a match is tied at the end of regulation playing time, the teams concerned will be required to play for an extra five minutes. If after this extra period, the match is still tied, a “sudden death” period of play will be introduced as follows:

The “sudden death” period of play will begin with a toss of a coin for choice of goal or first centre pass.

Play will come to an end as soon as a team scores on its opponent’s centre pass.

15. DISCIPLINE

(a) *The breaking of rules and/or the employment of any action not covered by the wording of the rules, in a manner contrary to the spirit of game is not permitted.*

(b) *For rough or dangerous play or misconduct, in addition to awarding the appropriate penalty, an umpire may:*

(i) *Order a player to leave the court, but only when sure that the ordinary penalty is insufficient and, except in extreme cases, only after a warning.*

(ii) *Send a player off the court for a specified part of the game e.g. until the next goal is scored, until the next interval or for the rest of the game. When a player is suspended, that player may not be replaced. After completion of the suspension period, the player may return to the game after a goal is scored or at the next interval.*

(c) *Any player/players insulting or assaulting an umpire, match official, officer of the Sports Division/Ministry, guests of the Sports Division, principals, teachers, parents, players and spectators will be suspended from further participation in the competition, until the outcome of an investigation to determine whether further disciplinary action will be warranted.*

16. WITHDRAWAL OF TEAMS

Schools are expected to complete all match fixtures.

In the event that a school withdraws from the league/festival/match after having started or confirmed its participation, the matter will be investigated, and if the reason for such withdrawal proves unsatisfactory to the Sports Division, the matter will be brought to the attention of the Chief Education Officer for necessary action. Students/pupils from the school concerned will not be considered for national selection and awards.

17. AWARDS

The following awards will be presented at the Annual Schools Sports Awards Ceremony:

- *Champion Team Award*
- *2nd Place Team Award*
- *Most Valuable Player (MVP) Award*
- *Most Outstanding Shoot Award*
- *Most Disciplined Team Award*
- *Zone Winner Award*

18. CRITERIA FOR MVP, MOST DISCIPLINED AND OUTSTANDING SHOOT AWARDS

MOST VALUABLE PLAYER (MVP)

- *Coaches shall nominate 1st and 2nd choices for MVP on the opponents team after each game during the Round Robin phase.*
- *1st choice nominees will receive a score of 10 points*

- 2nd choice nominees will receive a score of 5 points
- Player with most points will be declared MVP. In the event of a tie, the Sports Division will declare the MVP.

Note: A team's MVP is the player who had the greatest positive impact on her team's performance.

MOST DISCIPLINED TEAM

Teams will be penalized with negative points for ill-discipline as follow:

<i>Lateness:</i>	<i>arrival within ten minutes prior to start of a match(negative 5 points)</i>
	<i>arrival after the scheduled start of match(negative 10 points)</i>
<i>No Show:</i>	<i>unexcused or unacceptable reason for "No Show" (Team will be not be considered for award)</i>
<i>Improper Dress:</i>	<i>negative 2 points per player out of uniform</i>
<i>Caution (Warning):</i>	<i>negative 1 Point for player</i>
<i>Improper Coaches Behaviour:</i>	<i>coaches will be penalized on a scale of negative 2 to negative 10 points</i>
<i>Suspension of Players:</i>	<i>one center pass (Negative 2 points per player) until next interval (Negative 3 points per player) for rest of the game (negative 5 points per player) for the rest of the competition (negative 10 points)</i>

Teams with the least negative points will be declared the Most Disciplined Team. In the case of a tie, the Sports Division will determine the winner of the award.

MOST OUTSTANDING SHOOT

The Most Outstanding Shoot will be determined as follows:

- Total number of goals scored by a shoot (GS/GA) during the Round Robin Stage(N) multiplied by the player's shooting percentage(P) (accuracy).
- Player with the highest score (ie $N \times P / 100$) will be declared the Most Outstanding Shoot. In the event, of a tie, the following will apply:
 1. player with most goals
 2. player with greatest accuracy

19. GENERAL

- (a) School teachers are expected to ensure that their players and supporters exhibit attitudes conducive to maintaining the good name of the sport and their respective institutions.
- (b) All players and team officials are required to observe the edict: **"THE UMPIRE'S DECISION IS FINAL"**
- (b) School teachers are required to arrange for their teams to arrive as a group when turning up for their matches.
